7	Representative of Department of Science & Technology (DST), New Delhi	Member

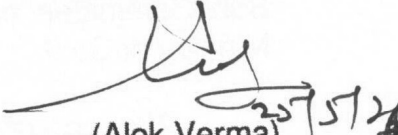
2. Chairman of the Technical Sub-Committee of the Standing Scientific Research Committee (SSRC) will also be a member of the SSRC.

3. The mandates of the Technical Sub-Committee will be as under-

- (i) To examine and review, periodically, the scientific and technological research requirements in the coal sector;
- (ii) To plan, programme, budget and oversee the implementation of R&D projects in the coal sector;
- (iii) To identify the organisations to which research programmes are to be assigned for implementation;
- (iv) To take decisions, wherever necessary, regarding the development of prototypes, undertaking of pilot plant studies and determining the agencies for their funding, testing and evaluation;
- (v) To seek the application for funding of R&D work done;
- (vi) To perform such other work as may be necessary, from time to time, in regard to furtherance of R&D activities in the coal sector;
- (vii) To aid and advise the SSRC in making decisions on the proposals.

4. Director(T/RD&T), CMPDI will provide necessary assistance to the committee.
