- (iv) To take decision, wherever necessary, regarding the development of prototypes, undertaking of pilot plant studies and determining the agencies for their funding, testing and evaluation;
- (v) To seek application of the funding of R&D work done;
- (vi) To perform such other work as may be necessary, from time to time, in regard to furtherance of R&D activities in the coal sector
- (vii) To aid and advise the SSRC in taking decisions on the proposals.
